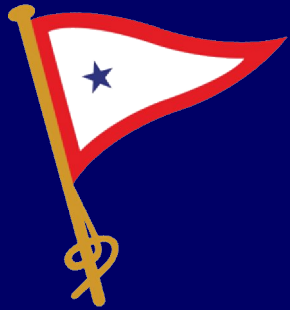

Our floating clubhouse in New York Harbor

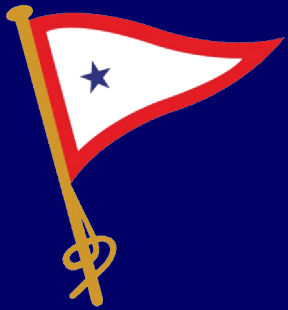
One of Manhattan Sailing Club's assets is the "Honorable William Wall," our floating clubhouse in New York Harbor.

The clubhouse has an open air bar on the upper deck which affords unmatched views of the sailing, the harbor and the skyline. The upper deck is carpeted and has beautiful wood railings, patio furniture and a great sound system.



The clubhouse is a USCG-certified vessel which can hold up to 140 guests. It is anchored in the harbor in the cove north of Ellis Island. Transportation to and from North Cove is provided by Admiral's Launch, a USCG-certified vessel.

One opportunity for members of the Manhattan Sailing Club is to hold your birthday party on the floating clubhouse. This is a magnificent way to celebrate your special occasion and show your guests the sailboats, harbor and skyline.



Days of Operation & the View!

What its like from the clubhouse

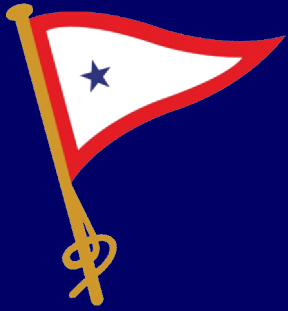
You can schedule a Member Birthday Party when the clubhouse is normally open:

- Tuesday to Friday, 5:30 to 10 p.m.
- Saturday, 1 to 9 p.m.

Tuesday and Wednesday are the J/24 race nights at the club. Thursday is the J/105 and PHRF race night. Friends of the racers often come out to watch the competition. Wednesday is also when sailing school graduates are invited out.

Any day at the clubhouse is magnificent. There is often a fresh breeze blowing. The views are stunning. You can spend hours just staring at the horizon. The sunsets are breathtaking. And after the sun goes down, the lights of the city come on and the view is even more magical.





How it Works & the Costs

Choose which option is best for you

Member Birthdays provide you with a cost-effective way to celebrate. You can reserve a section of the upper deck. The rest of the clubhouse stays open for general membership.

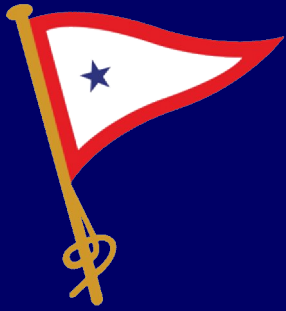
With 25 guests or more, you can reserve $\frac{1}{4}$ of the upper deck.
With 50 guests or more, you can reserve $\frac{1}{2}$ the upper deck.

For cost structure, you can select one of these four options:

- Option 1 - Guests pay normal charges (\$10 launch fee and cash bar).
- Option 2 - Member pays launch fees (\$10 per person for non-members) and guests pay for drinks.
- Option 3 - Member pays for drinks and guests pay for launch fees.
- Option 4 - Member pays for launch fees and bar charges.

(Members can also privatize the clubhouse for events.

Additional Details

Number, flags, catering, music & launch.

The number of concurrent Member Birthday Parties will normally be limited to 2.

The clubhouse will fly a Birthday Flag if provided by the member. This will be the same size and design as the club burgee normally flown from the clubhouse but with the member name and birthday in the center. Cost is usually about \$150.

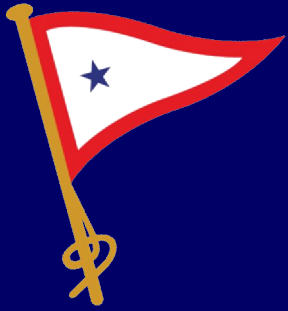
Members can bring their own food (but not any drinks or beverages). Catering can be arranged through a club-approved vendor.

The clubhouse is equipped with a sound system. Normal club music will be played during Member Birthday Parties. Members may hire a club-approved DJ if they wish.

Launch spots are first-come first-served as normal. However, if the clubhouse nears capacity, Birthday Party guests will be invited to the front of the launch line. The launch can move approximately 40 people each 30 minutes. A second launch can be added for the evening in order to move guests quicker. The cost to add a second launch is \$800 for the evening.

The Member Birthday Program is for personal events only and not for corporate or business related events.

The club reserves the right to privatize the clubhouse for special events. If a day is privatized, the club will try to inform members who have scheduled birthdays a minimum of 3 weeks in advance.
